FHWN Teams: Min. 4 - max. 10 members of start-up teams will be selected based on the following selection criteria:

POPS (acronym for Point One Pitch Your Start-Up)

- annual event organized by the Point One incubator at CZU,
- open to the public,
- attracting around 250 visitors, primarily CZU students interested in exploring entrepreneurial opportunities beyond their academic fields

Programme Objectives of the CZU & FHWN Academic Innovation Partnership

Provide student enterprises and spin-offs with access to business experts and coaching opportunities through participation in the partner university's annual start-up competition;

Introduce projects to potential investors, industry professionals, and fellow researchers;

Validate the feasibility and market potential of the envisaged / developed product, service, or solution; and Facilitate peer-to-peer exchange and expert feedback to refine business strategies.

By integrating structured mentoring, networking, and direct participation in entrepreneurial competitions, the partnership aims at fostering a sustainable cross-border collaboration in innovation and entrepreneurship!

Expected Participation

• FHWN Teams: Min. 4 – max. 10 members of start-up teams (selected through a competitive process organized by the FHWN StartUp Center)



- FHWN Staff: 2 representatives, including business mentors, faculty, and program coordinators
- **CZU Teams:** Min. 4 max. 8 start-up teams (selected through a competitive process organised by the Point One incubator)
- **CZU Staff:** Min. 9 max. 15 representatives, including business mentors, faculty and program coordinators
- **CZU Visitors:** Min. 90 max. 300 (visitors of the POPS competition, primarily CZU students, researchers, and staff engaged in entrepreneurship and the third mission of universities. Partners of the Point One incubator, investors, representatives of venture capital funds, and industry experts. Founders of successful projects/companies that the Point One incubator has supported on their entrepreneurial journey).

Joint Pitch Competition ,Point One Pitch Your Start-Up' (POPS) Insurance Information for Students



FHWN participants to the Joint Pitch Competition POPS are required to ensure sufficient insurance cover for their mobility abroad.





It is **mandatory** to take out the following insurance cover:

- Travel insurance (including against damage to or loss of luggage)
- Liability insurance (including professional or personal liability, if applicable)
- · Accident and illness insurance (including total or partial incapacity for work)
- **Death** (including repatriation from projects abroad)

In addition, we recommend taking out cancellation insurance.

Please make sure that the local area of validity includes your host country, the Czech Republic, with respect to all of the insurance types stated.
